CHOCOLATE CHIP MUFFINS

Chocolate chip muffins are one of my favorite cakes and they are easy to make.

Here are the ingredients for my recipe.

½ cup of butter or margarine

2 table spoons of dark brown sugar

2 eggs

1 ½ cups of plain flour

1 table spoon of baking powder

½ cup milk






