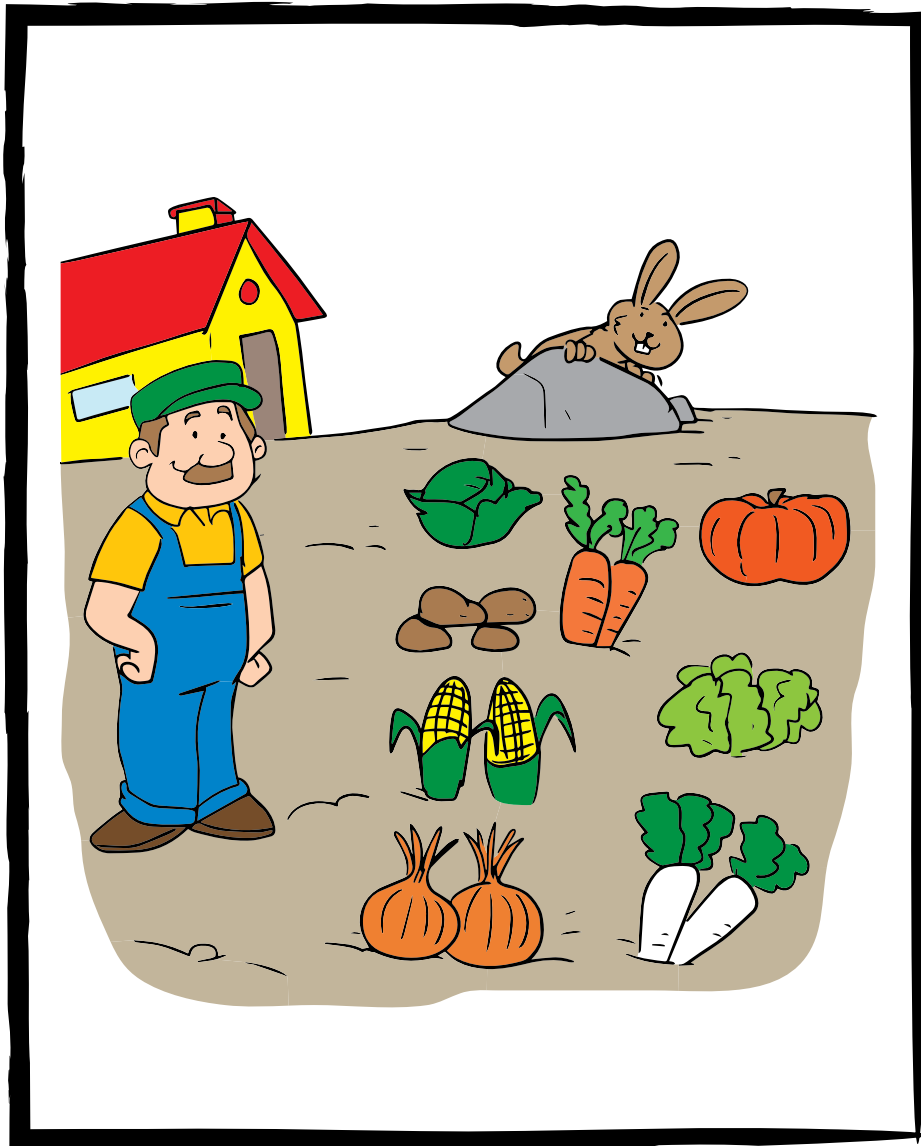

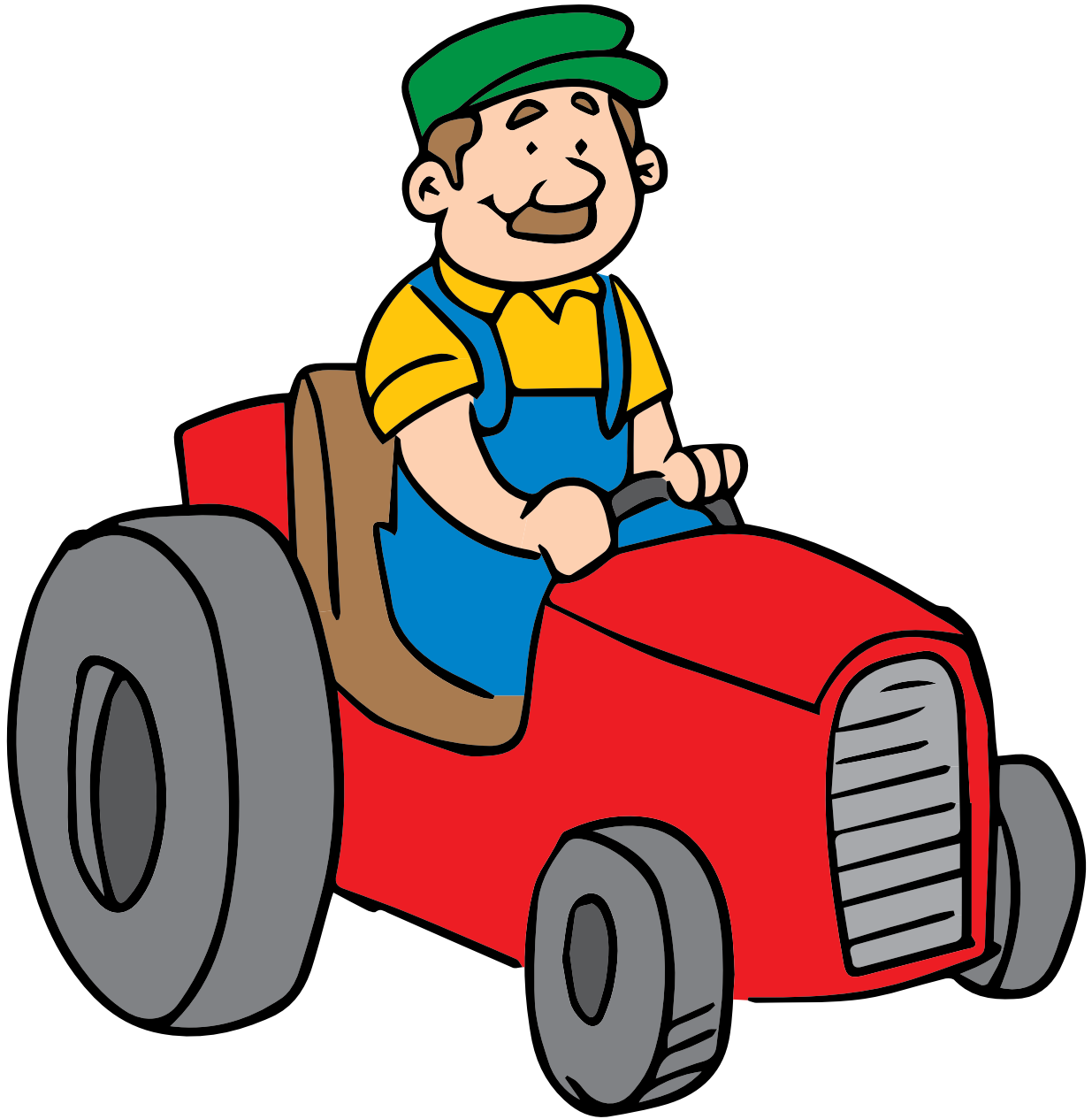
# The Farmer's Vegetables

He is working on his farm.



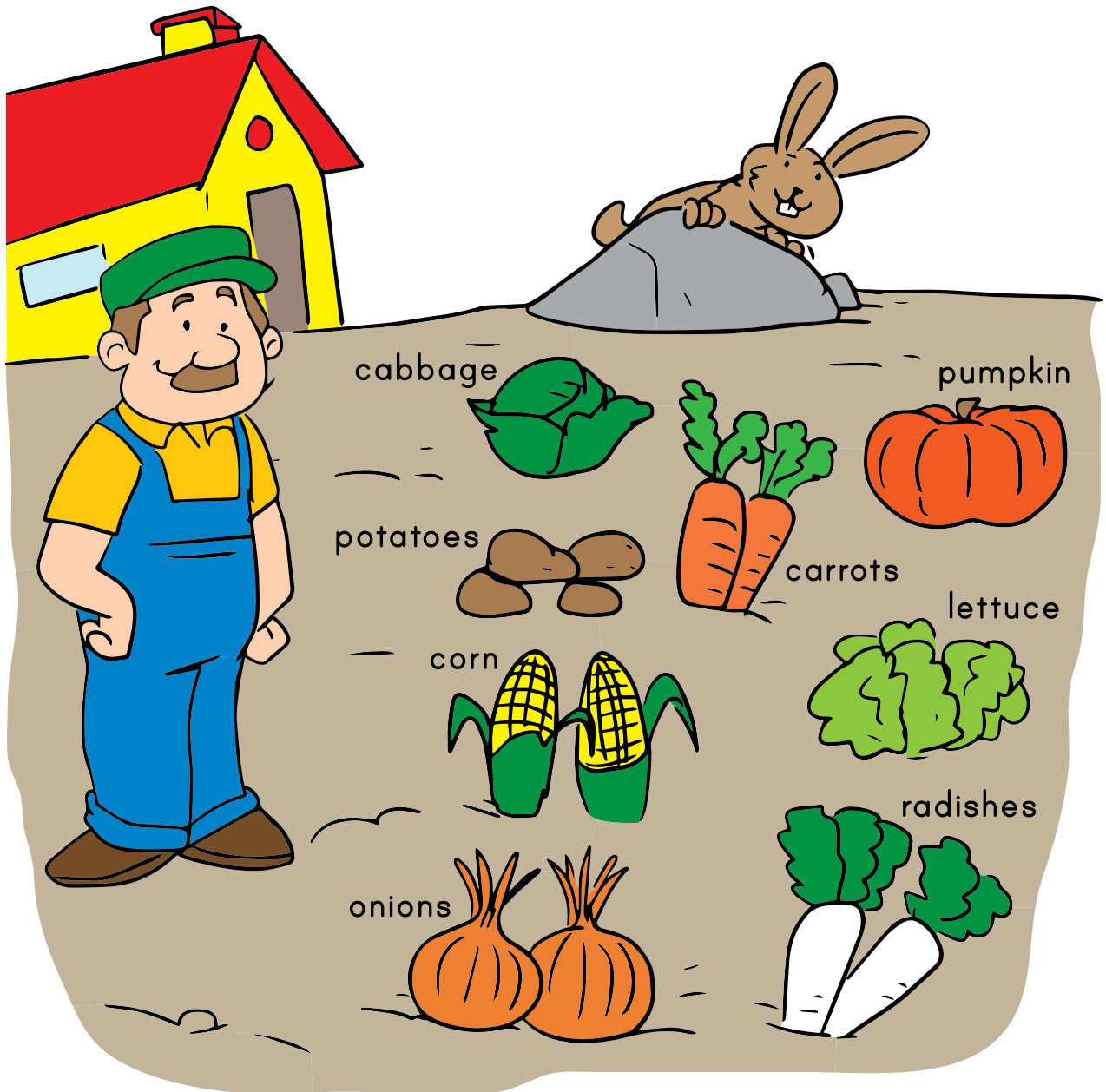
The farmer wanted to

his field.

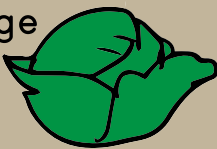


Some days it was sunny

grow.



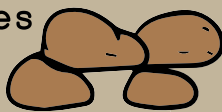
cabbage

potatoes



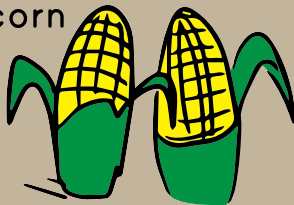
carrots



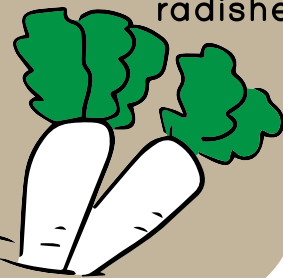
lettuce

rock.

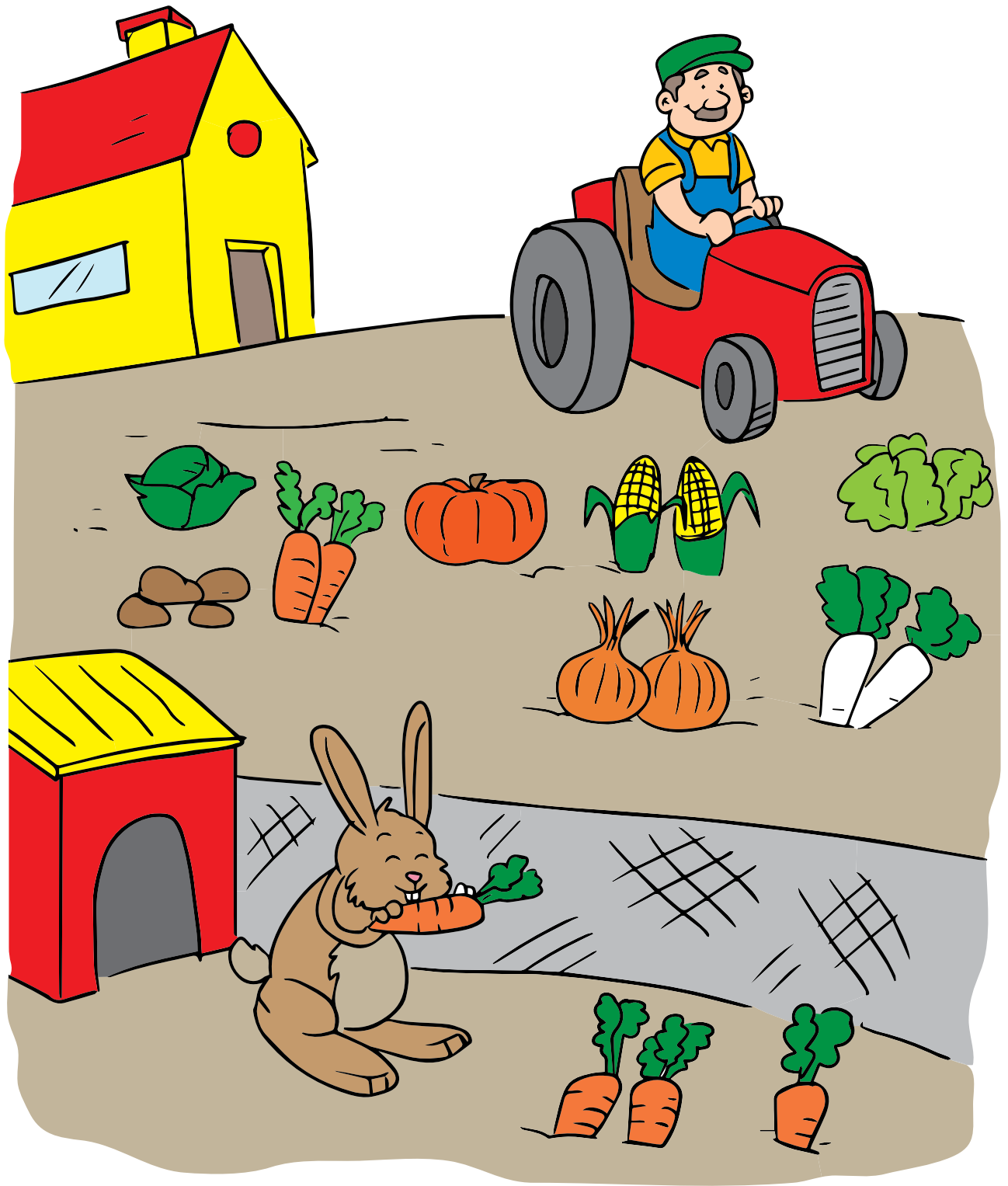
He waited and waited

Every day the farmer gives the rabbit lots of carrots to eat.

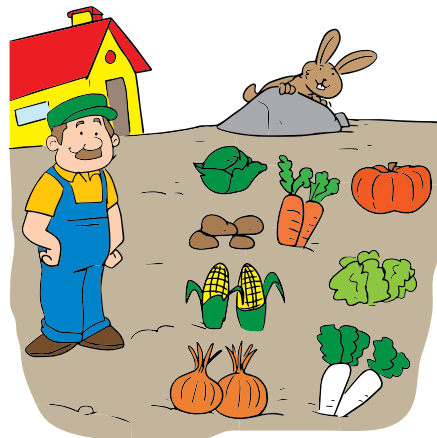
The rabbit and the farmer are both very happy.
